

Second edition of the EurAsian Geosynthetics Symposium meets aim of building bridges across Europe and Asia

3 December 2019

The second EurAsian Geotextiles Symposium (EAGS) was held in Beijing, 18 - 19 November, attracting around 150 participants who enjoyed a productive 2-day event exploring the latest technical developments and case studies in the geosynthetics sphere and exchanging best practices in standardisation and sustainability.



Co-organised by the China Industrial Textiles Industry Association (CNITA) and EDANA, and supported by the International Geosynthetics Society (IGS) and the Industrial Fabrics Association International (IFAI), the EAGS is a unique networking event attracting professionals from across the sector, from academic experts to manufacturers and equipment suppliers. A tabletop exhibition was also organized to showcase industry developments and facilitate interaction.

Standardisation, sustainability and environmental protection were key themes at the event with many presentations illustrating how geosynthetics can provide solutions in these areas.
