Key benefits

- A single harmonised industry standard for hygiene suppliers: developed by EDANA with hygiene-industry stakeholders
- Conducted by **independent third-party auditors** – objective, consistent, and efficient
- Reduce duplication: **no more multiple audits** with overlapping requirements from different converters
- Audit results **are owned by you**, the supplier, and you decide with whom to share them.
- Strengthen your market position: demonstrate to current & future customers you meet recognised quality benchmarks.

How it works

1. Download the “EDANA Standard & Guidance” and review requirements.
2. Apply for an audit (site based) via the EDANA website or edana.qap@bsigroup.com
3. Return the signed quotation to BSI.
4. BSI contacts you to schedule the audit.
5. BSI conducts the on-site audit
(typical duration ≈ 3 days)
6. Receive your audit report, rating and list of non-conformities (NCs). Submit your Corrective Action Plan (CAP).
7. You grant access to your audit results via the BSI Connect Portal to your converter/ customers as needed.

Converter in The AHP business ?

For converters in the hygiene & wipes industry: tap into the QAP to simplify supplier quality oversight.

Key benefits

- Collectively use a single **harmonised standard** built by the industry for the industry – reducing complexity and cost
- **Improve your risk-management** & supplier assurance: independent audits, professional auditing partner, structured reporting
- Access to audit reports from your suppliers who have joined QAP – less duplication, **more transparency**
- **Free up internal resources** to focus on innovation or continuous improvement – rather than repeatedly auditing the same sites

How it works

1. Register as a Converter in the QAP via EDANA (form or call)
2. Encourage (or require) your key suppliers to participate in the QAP.
3. Once the supplier's audit is completed and you've been granted access, you and your team members can access the report and NCs via the BSI Connect Portal.
4. Use the audit outcomes in your supplier management process (e.g., supplier qualification, review, risk profile).
5. Repeat or monitor as supplier contracts evolve – no fixed certification expiry, supplier initiates next audit when needed
